Unionville Sports Council announces Exelon Generation of Kennett Square as Corporate Sponsor

The Unionville Sports Council (USC) announced Exelon Generation of Kennett Square today as their first Corporate Sponsor. Exelon will contribute an immediate \$10,000 to the Council to go towards the organization's efforts to improve Physical Education Facility and Fields at the Unionville Middle School/High School Complex.

Documented research at the secondary school level has indicated a direct correlation between a student's Physical Activity and improved Academic performance. In addition, Congress is considering the Fit (Fitness Integrated with Teaching) Act H.R. 3257, which will recommend 45 minutes per day of Physical Education. The bill will also require public school districts to report on their Physical Education space allocation.

In an on-site survey of 16 Chester County high schools, Unionville High School was either last or next to last in nearly every measurable Physical Education facility category, including important overcrowding metrics such as Gym Space per Student and Gym Space per Sports participant. The approved renovation project will bring the High School to only the 6th largest in Gym Space per student and 10th largest in Gym Space per Sports participant.

“Our Board is thrilled with Exelon Generation's acknowledgement and support of our efforts to create better students through Sports and Physical Activity Initiatives”, says Council President Joe Carney. “Our projects include better fields and an investment in cardiovascular exercise equipment.”

Unionville Sports Council will be formally kicking off their campaign for a new stadium field playing surface on Friday night August 29th, during the scheduled football game vs. Interboro. In addition, Kate Barber, Unionville alum and US Olympic Field Hockey Captain, will be the featured speaker at the organization's Trade Show Silent Auction on Friday, September 26th.
